 - Formal three-hour block on Wednesday mornings including Simulation lab, Mock Oral board preparation, Ultrasound training, Guest lectures, OMM Lab, Morbidity and Mortality conference, Clinical Case Review, Journal Club, Fetal Heart Rate tracing review, and Quality Assurance sessions.
